

HERITAGE GRAFFITI REMOVER

Heritage Graffiti Remover is designed to

Remove graffiti from porous heritage surfaces such as sandstone and limestone. It is designed to remove thin layers of paint (graffiti), either marker pens or spray paints. It can also be used on some sensitive surfaces such as the plastic found in play grounds.

Heritage Graffiti Remover is NOT designed to

It is not designed to remove thick layers of paint such as gloss paint or line marker paints. Whilst it can be used on some more sensitive surfaces, it may damage others, so always test a small area first.

Avoid splashing onto aluminium window frames and galvanized surfaces.

Health & Safety

- Please read the safety instructions prior to commencing.
- Protective gloves and safety glasses must be worn at all times.
- Application is by means of a nylon brush. This product is not designed to be sprayed or atomised.
- Dispose of run off in accordance with local regulations. Run off should not go into rivers.

Instructions

Step 1

- Heritage Graffiti Remover should be decanted into a smaller vessel and is then applied liberally over the graffiti using a nylon brush.
- Three flood coats should be applied, with just a minute's gap between applications.
- Slight agitation may give better results.
- Do not allow the solutions to dry out. If it does dry, simply apply one more coat prior to washing the graffiti off.
- On highly porous sandstone, or on very old or sun baked graffiti the solution should be given up to 10 minutes dwell time. The rule of thumb for best results in these situations is "the longer and wetter the better".

Step 2

- Jet wash the graffiti off using hot or cold water at low pressure.
- It may be necessary to repeat the process and allow further dwell time.

Other Information

- Heritage Graffiti Remover can be used in the rain on walls but exposed monuments that are running wet may need to be left for a dry day.
- When working with Heritage it may be preferable to leave a small percentage of graffiti rather than to over clean a monument. This will generally quickly get covered in algae.
- Heritage is particularly good at removing black, white and yellow spray paints. It can also be used in conjunction with Spraycan Paint Remover (to replace the middle of the three coats) to give impressive cleaning results on all porous surfaces.
